Seeking more Light in Freemasonry in Queensland

*Edited to fit (Two Pages)

Who is Grand Lodge? Article 2.1 of our Constitutions says: “Grand Lodge is composed of the Grand Master, the Grand Officers for the time being, the Past Grand Officers being subscribing members of any lodge on the register of Grand Lodge, and all subscribing members of any lodge on the register of Grand Lodge who are Master Masons.” So every MM is a member of Grand Lodge.

Who actually runs Freemasonry in Queensland? Article 4 of our Constitutions says: “Supreme superintending authority: Grand Lodge possesses the supreme superintending authority, and alone has the inherent power of enacting laws and regulations for the government of the Craft, and of altering, repealing, and abrogating them, always taking care that the antient landmarks of the Order be preserved. In the words of the Stone Cutters from the Simpsons, WE do – assuming we attend the Quarterly Communications where decisions are voted on.

How do WE as Grand Lodge delegate that authority and who to? Article 7 of our Constitutions says: “Grand Lodge is cognisant of the need to ensure the corporate, ceremonial and judicial aspects of Grand Lodge operate competitively, efficiently, effectively and fairly to promote the interests of Grand Lodge and its members for current and future generations.

To assist in achieving this;

7.1. The General Board of Directors is given the power by this constitution to focus on strategic direction and the control and management of Grand Lodge's resources.

7.2. The Ceremonial Board is given the power under this constitution to control and manage the ceremonial protocols and activities of Grand Lodge.

7.3. The Judicial Board is given the power by this constitution to focus on judicial matters associated with Grand Lodge and its members.

7.4. The Nominations Panel is given the power by this constitution to make appointments of Directors or members of the various boards of Grand Lodge except those specifically noted elsewhere in this constitution.

7.5. The component boards of Grand Lodge and reporting relationships are shown in ANNEX A.

7.6. Note that the Board of Benevolence and the Geriatric Medical Foundation of Queensland (Now Aegium) have separate and distinct constitutions.”

Those with experience in Corporate Governance will know the Australian Institute of Company Directors. They advise that: “The boards of organisations often establish committees to deal with complex or specialised issues and to use directors’ time more efficiently. Committees make recommendations for action to the full board, which retains collective responsibility for decision making.”

Each of our Boards has indeed established committees in line with best practice governance models.

General Board of Directors

The General Board of Directors has established three Committees:

- Finance and Audit Committee
- Membership Media and Marketing Committee
- Property Committee

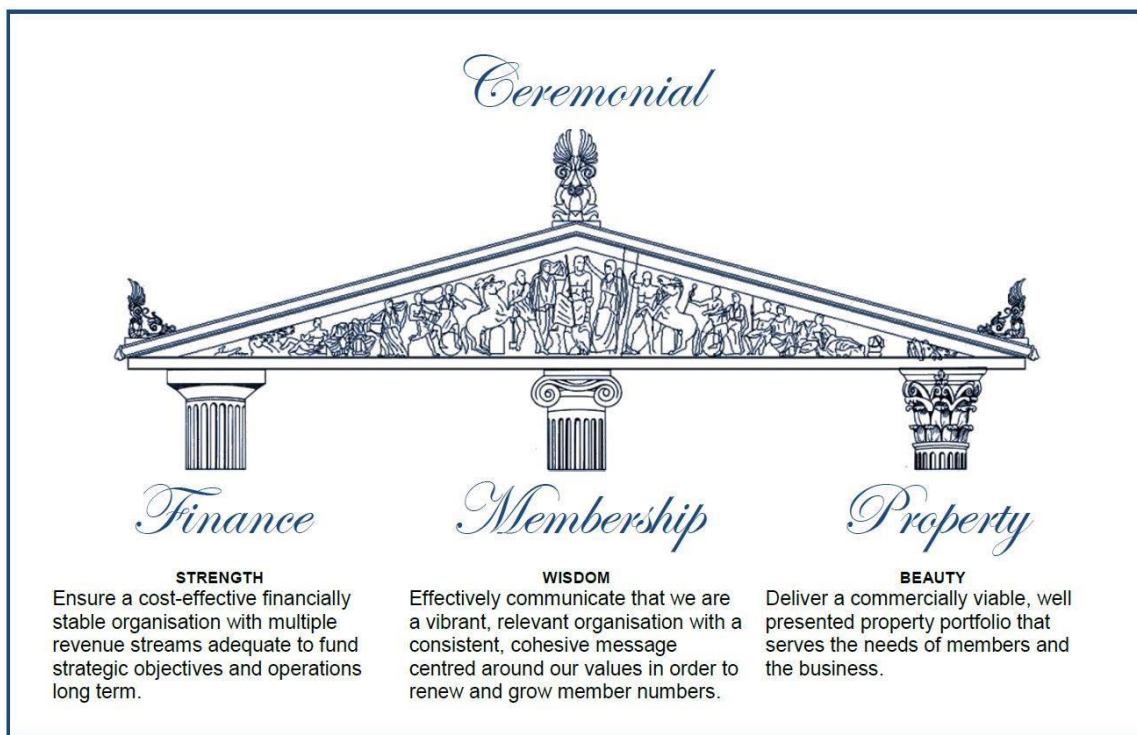
This is completely in line with our three Pillars Strategy of Finance, Membership, and Property all supporting the heart of Freemasonry, the Ceremonial which has its own Board and its own Committees.

These three GBoD committees investigate and make decisions or recommendations within their respective areas of delegated responsibility. The GBoD makes the final decisions on any and all matters raised or recommended to them, and approves any expenditure related to those decisions. The Executive Manager's role is then to ensure that the will of the GBoD (and the other two Boards) is implemented by directing the executive team, i.e. the administration office.

(Executive is defined as: relating to or having the power to put plans or actions into effect)

Brethren, such is the nature of our Constitution, that as some must of necessity rule and teach, so others must submit and learn; humility in each is an essential qualification. The Brethren who have been selected



to assist the WM in the ruling and governing of the Lodge are too well acquainted with the principles of Freemasonry and the laws of our institution to warrant any fear that they will be found wanting in the discharge of the duties of their respective offices, or that they will exceed the powers with which they have been entrusted; and you Brethren are of too generous a disposition to envy their preferment.

I trust, therefore, you will have but one aim, to unite in the grand design of being happy and communicating happiness; and as Freemasonry has been formed and perfected with so much unanimity and concord, so may it long continue and remain a monument
